

Title	Job Description
Game Theoretician	Understands the various motivations and factors which contribute to decisions made by states, statesmen, and other organizations and individuals relevant to the international community. Can predict the most likely result to arise from conflict situations based on human decision-making rationales and game theory. Can offer advice on the best course of action to take by forecasting the likely response of the other party and the future consequences of a particular action.
Dem., Chair of Sen. Foreign Rel. Comm.	Responsible for reviewing legislation related to US foreign policy. Can work toward bipartisan solutions and offer bipartisan advice related to US engagement with other governments, especially those initiatives involving a need for funding. Has an established duty to "clear" all treaties being entered into by the US.
Ranking Repub. on Sen. Foreign Rel. Comm.	Responsible for reviewing legislation related to US foreign policy. Can work toward bipartisan solutions and offer bipartisan advice related to US engagement with other governments, especially those initiatives involving the need for funding. Has an established duty to "clear" all treaties being entered into by the US.
Rep. of Russia	Has a clear understanding of Russian interests in the region and a clear vision for Russia's role in the region. Also has an understanding of what Russia is able to contribute to the solution.
U.S. Ambassador to U.N.	Understands US foreign policy objectives and promotes them, with an eye to multi-lateral country involvement. Can cooperate with other statesmen to achieve a common resolution.
Rep. of Iraqi Sunnis	Understands the driving principles of the Iraqi Shiite community and its political objectives. Promotes those objectives and ensures that their voice is heard.
Rep. of O.P.E.C.	Exercises a considerable amount of discretion in setting oil production rates and pricing. Anticipates changes in market demand and adjusts supply accordingly.
Rep. of al Qaeda	Acts and speaks with the objectives of al Qaeda in mind. May or may not be interested in diplomatic solutions.
Jon Stewart	Possesses an incisive wit which serves to uncover the ironies of conflict situations and the solutions proposed to address them. Has a fully functioning "B.S.-o-meter" that sifts truth from falsehood and sincere motives from disingenuous ones.
Attorney-General	Understands the legal ramifications of US actions and policies. Can advise on potential legal problems (e.g., use of torture, suspension of habeus corpus)
Rep. of Iraqi Shiites	Understands the driving principles of the Iraqi Shiite community and its political objectives. Promotes those objectives and ensures that their voice is heard.
Secretary of Treasury	Can advise on the financial feasibility of US initiatives. Also understands the implication of US actions on the global economy and gives advice with a mind to managing US debt. Sits on the United States National Security Council.
President Barack Obama	Has a clear understanding of United States interests in the region and a clear vision for the US's role therein. Determines the degree to which US action will be done in cooperation with other countries, and which ones. Understands the roles of other players so that he can delegate tasks. Makes the final decision.
Ranking Repub. on Sen. Foreign Rel. Comm.	Responsible for reviewing legislation related to US foreign policy. Can work toward bipartisan solutions and offer bipartisan advice related to US engagement with other governments. Has an established duty to "clear" all treaties being entered into by the US.
Mahmoud Ahmadinejad of Afghanistan	Has a clear understanding of Iranian interests in the region and a clear vision for Iran's role in the region. Also has an understanding of what Iran is able to contribute to the solution.
Secretary of Defense	Advises the President on military defense matters and translates the President's vision into defense policy and military action. Can judge the feasibility of different plans and anticipate negative consequences of military actions.
Director of C.I.A.	Will keep abreast of political, military, and business movements in the region which may impact US plans and interests. Sets a course of action for intelligence gathering in the region.
Secretary of Energy	Has knowledge of the energy resources located in the region and the consequences of military action on the availability of oil globally. Also understands US energy needs.
