



# MAIL-IN VOTING STEPS

## for Missouri



Because of COVID-19, mail-in voting is becoming a more popular way to vote. It's safe but slow; make sure you act early. If you need or want to stay home on Election Day, follow these steps:



Request your mail-in ballot form.



Send your request to your local election authority.



After you receive & fill out your ballot, notarize its envelope.



Mail your ballot to your local election authority through US mail.

- Mail-in ballot request forms sent by mail must be received by your election authority no later than 5:00 p.m. on the second Wednesday prior to any election.

**August Election deadline: July 22 at 5 p.m.**

**November Election deadline: October 21 at 5 p.m.**

- Mail-in ballots must be returned by mail in the provided envelope notarized. To be counted, mail-in ballots must be received by your election authority at or before the closing of the polls on Election Day (7:00 p.m.).
